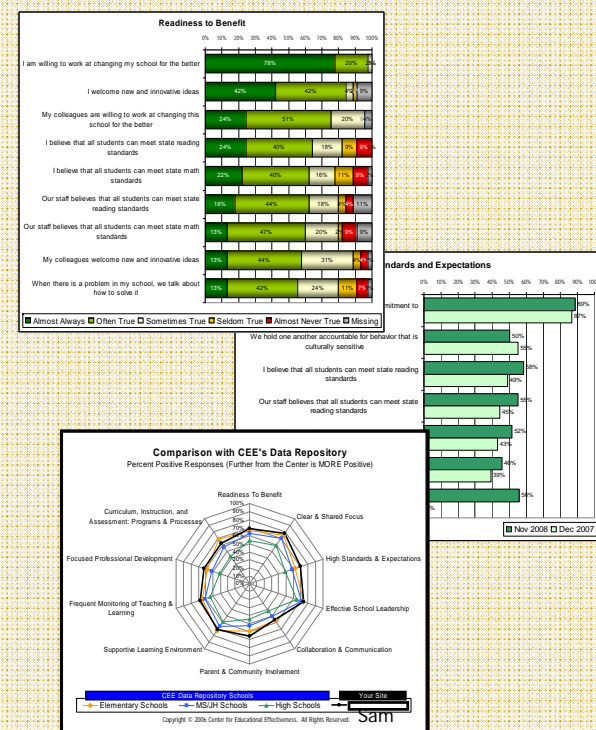




EDUCATIONAL EFFECTIVENESS SURVEY - STUDENT v2.0
